# What to bring to the hospital..

- Your Joint Replacement Guidebook
- Loose comfortable clothes (allowing for surgeon to see your dressing)
- Glasses, hearing aids, & dentures
- Sleep apnea machines & power cord
- Electronic devices & power cords
- Walker

**Do not bring jewelry, cash or home medication**



# REGISTRATION

- 1) Check in at the main registration desk in the front lobby
- 2) Go to Day Surgery with your face sheet and arm band!



# DAY SURGERY

- ✓ Change into a hospital gown
  - ✓ Nurse Interview
  - ✓ IV placed
  - ✓ Surgical site prepared
  - ✓ Surgeon Consent
- ✓ Program Coordinators check-in
  - ✓ Ask any last-minute questions
- ✓ Anesthesia provider discusses the plan & gets your consent



## OPERATING ROOM



- Everyone will be wearing masks, gloves, & surgical scrubs to protect you from infection
- You will slide from your pre-op bed onto the operating table

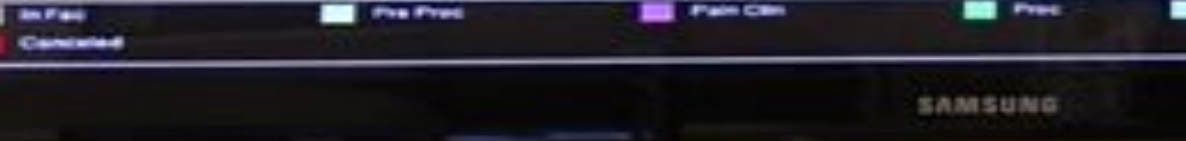

# Recovery (PACU)

## After surgery:

- Supplemental oxygen
- IV fluids
- Vital Signs are taken
- Post-op Nausea/Vomiting
- SCDs are placed
- Cold gel packs applied
- Sips of water & crackers or apple sauce
- Start oral pain medication
