Your Rights

You have the right to:

- Get a copy of your medical record. We do not charge for record copies.
- Request a correction to your medical record
- Request confidential communication
- Ask us to limit the information we share
- Request a list of those to whom we have shared your information
- Choose someone to act on your behalf
- File a complaint if you believe your privacy rights have been violated

Your Choices

You have choices in how we use and share information as we:

- Tell family and friends about your condition
- Include you in a hospital directory
- Provide mental health care
- Market our services
- Raise Funds

Our Uses & Disclosures

We may use and share your information as we:

- Treat you
- Operate our organization
- Bill for your services
- Help with public health and safety issues
- Do research
- Comply with the law
- Respond to organ and tissue donation requests
- Work with a medical examiner or funeral director
- Address workers' compensation, law enforcement, and other government requests
- Respond to lawsuits and legal actions.

Our Responsibilities

- We are required by law to maintain the privacy and security of your protected health information.
- We will let you know promptly if a breach occurs that may have compromised the privacy or security of your information.
- We must follow the duties and privacy practices described in the full Notice and offer you a copy of it.
- We will not use or share your information other than as described in the full Notice unless you tell us we can, in writing. If you tell us we can, you may change your mind at any time. Let us know in writing if you change your mind.
